Great Northern Corporation's Diaper Bank just got a boost with a \$1,500 grant from the Pacific Power Foundation to purchase infant through toddler sized diapers and diaper wipes that will be made available through the network of Siskiyou County Family Resource Centers and at GNC's office in Weed.

"The goal of the Diaper Bank is that no parent be put in the position of having to choose between paying for utilities or food or purchasing diapers," said Crystal Aston, GNC Project Manager. "We believe that every baby deserves clean diapers and we want to help out parents who are struggling to afford them." The program relies on the honor system for receiving assistance up to twice per year and subject to availability.
